

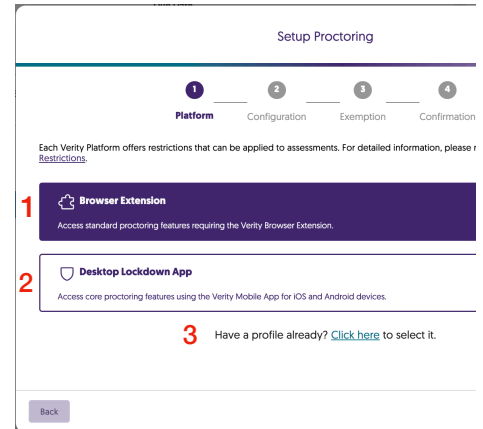

Test Settings Explained

Setup Proctoring



- 1 Browser Extension- Students install a browser (Google) extension to facilitate using the tool.
- 2 Desktop Lockdown App - Students are required to download and install an application to their computers. The lockdown app provides additional security settings that will be highlighted later in this literature. **NOTE:** The lockdown browser cannot be used on a Chromebook

Setup Proctoring



RECORD

Record the student with video, audio and screen tracking.

Record Video - the students are recorded in their testing environment through their webcams.

Enable the following sub-settings by clicking the checkbox next to the setting.

a. Bypass Mode: Test takers can continue their assessment if their webcam disconnects.

b. Detect Multiple people: The student's webcam will monitor whether there is one person in view at all times.

c. Detect Suspicious Objects: Phones, monitors, and books will be flagged if in view of the student's webcam.

Record Video

Test-taker's camera will be recorded during the assessment.

Record Audio - record sound around the student through their computer's microphone.

Enable the following sub-settings by clicking the checkbox next to the setting.

d. Bypass Mode: Test takers will be able to continue their assessment if their recording device disconnects during the session.

e. Quiet Environment: Loud audio disturbances, such as speaking, will be flagged.



Record Audio

Test-taker's audio environment will be recorded during the assessment.

Record Screen - Students will be required to share their entire screen for recording.



Record Screen

Test-taker's entire screen will be recorded during the assessment.

Room Scan - RSCC as an institution has disabled this feature. Room scans are not available.

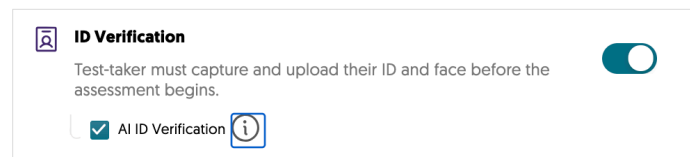
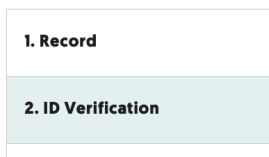

ID VERIFICATION

Students will be required to take a photo of their ID and face. The recording can be viewed with the student's test results from Verity Results link.



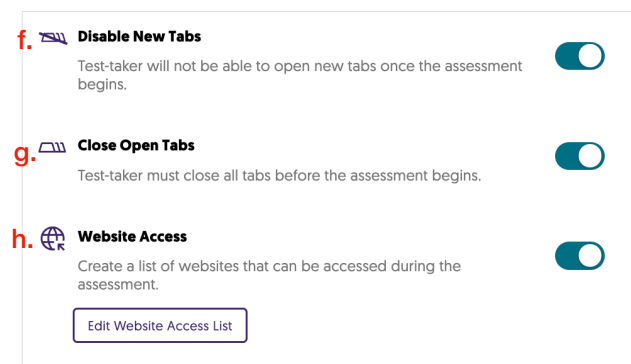
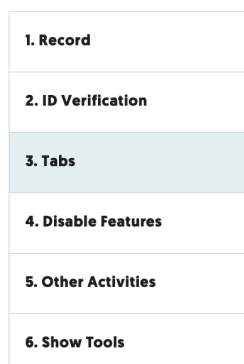
TABS

There are 3 tabs settings that can be enabled to control where students can navigate to during a Verity session.

f. Disable New Tabs - Once the assessment starts, opening new tabs will be prohibited.

g. Close Open Tabs - Once the assessment starts, all opened tabs will close.

h. Website Access - Create a list of websites that can be accessed during the assessment.



DISABLE FEATURES

There are several settings to prohibit students from copying quiz/exam material during a Verity session.

i. *Disable Clipboard* - Students will not be able to copy or paste material.

j. *Disable Printing* - Students will be unable to print from their computer.

k. *Disable Right Click* - The right-click functionality (mouse or trackpad) is disabled.

- i. **Disable Clipboard**
Test-taker will not be able to copy or paste items.
- j. **Disable Printing**
Test-taker will not be able to print.
- k. **Disable Right Click**
Test-taker will not be able to use the right click on their mouse or trackpad.

OTHER ACTIVITIES

There are two final settings that can be employed.

l. *Only One Screen*: Students can only have one monitor connected.

m. *Bypass Mode*: Students can continue with their assessment if multiple displays are detected.

n. *Record Web Traffic* - Websites approved to be accessible, will be recorded.

Test-taker must unplug additional displays to ensure only one screen is in use.

Websites accessed from a browser with the Verity extension installed will be recorded.

SHOW TOOLS

There are two auxiliary tools to use for student's convenience.

o. *Calculator* - Test takers will have access to a scientific calculator during their assessment.

p. *Whiteboard* - Test takers will have access to a scientific calculator during their assessment.

Setup Proctoring



EXEMPTION

Similar to special access in Momentum, Verity allows faculty to choose select students to allow different testing parameters

Test-Takers: Students will be added to the Test-Takers list once they have entered the course and enacted the Verity extension - i.e. they must open the Verity link under Assessments to be visible in the Test Takers list.

Exemption List: Students can be exempted from the Verity settings completely, or faculty can (q.) set unique testing profiles to the exempted student(s).

Add test-takers to an exemption list to deactivate Verity for them or apply unique proctoring profiles to those who are exempt.
